

## Requirements for Major Affiliation\*

---

Biological Engineering (BE)	At most one grade below C- in math and science courses and BEE 151 or its equivalent
Chemical Engineering (ChemE)	At most one grade below C- in chemistry, math, physics, and chemical engineering courses and a GPA $\geq 2.2$ in math, science, and chemical engineering courses
Civil Engineering (CE)	GPA $\geq 2.0$ for all engineering and science courses. At least C- in ENGRD 202 (or CHEM 208 for students who do not take ENGRD 202 before affiliation)
Computer Science (CS)	At least C in all completed COM S and math courses. GPA $\geq 2.7$ in COM S 211, 212, and 280. GPA $\geq 2.7$ in MATH 192 and 193. Visit the CS undergraduate office website to learn about alternative criteria for affiliation
Electrical and Computer Engineering (ECE)	At least C+ in MATH 293, PHYS 213, and one of ECE/ENGRD 210, ECE 220, and ENGRD 230 (all taken for 4 credits); GPA $\geq 2.5$ in the following courses if completed: MATH 192, 293, 294, PHYS 213, ECE/ENGRD 210; ECE 220; ENGRD 211, 230
Engineering Physics (EP)	At least B- in all required math and physics courses
Environmental Engineering (EnvE)-pending	GPA $\geq 2.0$ for all engineering and science courses. At least C- in ENGRD 202 or CHEM 257
Geological Science (Geo S)	Good academic standing in the College of Engineering
Independent Major (IM)	Cumulative GPA $\geq 2.0$
Information Science, Systems, Technology (ISST)	At least C in two of MATH 293, COM S 211, and ORIE 270. GPA $\geq 2.3$ in all completed required courses. For a repeated course, the most recent grade will be used.
Materials Science and Engineering (MSE)	At least C- in physics and chemistry courses and at least C in ENGRD 261 or 262
Mechanical Engineering (ME)	At least C- or better in math and science courses and in ENGRD 202
Operations Research and Engineering (ORE)	At least C- in MATH 190/191, 192, and ENGRD 270. GPA $\geq 2.0$ in math, science, and engineering courses (both overall and in the term immediately before affiliation)

\*Majors may impose alternative affiliation requirements for students applying for affiliation later than the first semester of the sophomore.
