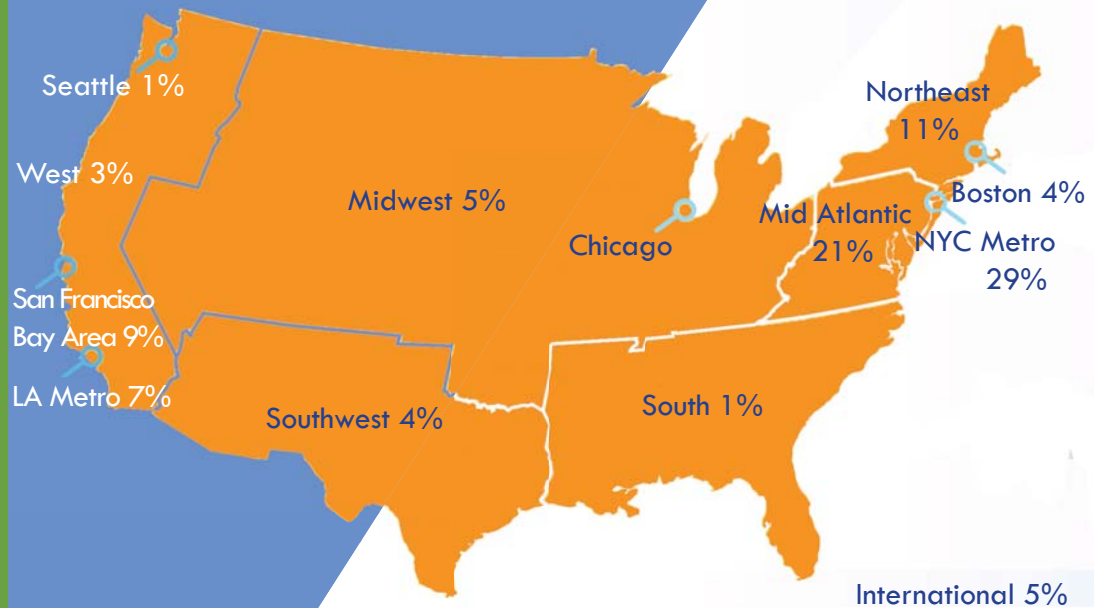

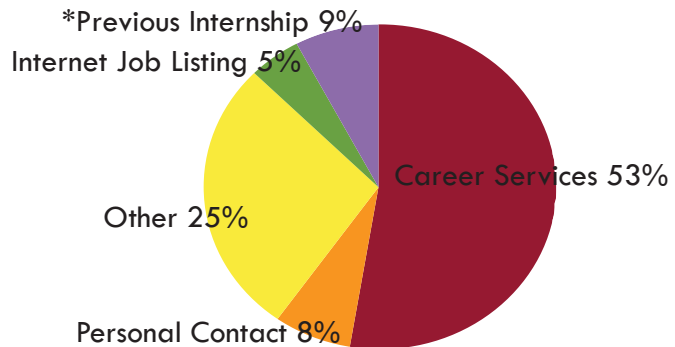

### Bachelor of Science Degree Program

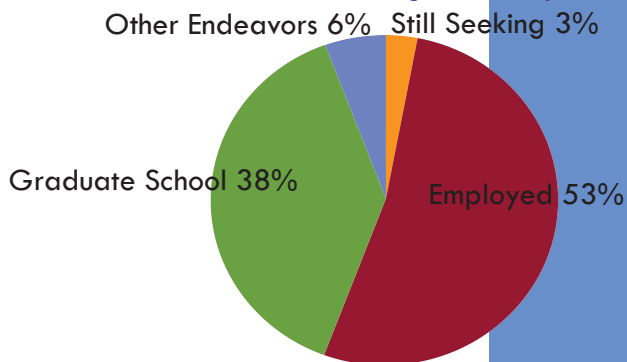
CEE offers two undergraduate curricula, Civil Engineering and Environmental Engineering. Graduates from both earn an accredited Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree bearing the title Civil Engineering. Within the program students may choose to focus in one of several areas including Civil Infrastructure, Fluid Mechanics/Hydrology, and Transportation Engineering as well as Environmental Engineering.

### Master of Engineering Degree

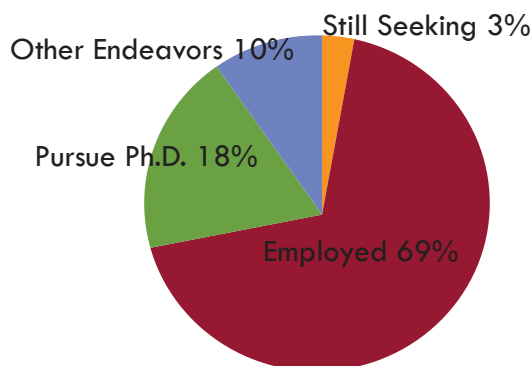
The Master of Engineering Degree (M.Eng.) is a nine-month program which focuses on coursework and design issues in Geotechnical, Structural, Environmental, Environmental and Water Resources Systems, Transportation Systems Engineering and Engineering Management. Students participate in a group design of a real-life project. Students can also pursue an Engineering Management M.Eng. through an in-depth, real world group design project, and course content in management science, project management, decision and risk analytics, information technology, finance and accounting, systems analysis, and organizational behavior to become effective engineering managers.
