

EnvE Study Abroad Planning Guide

This plan is offered as a general guide of how one might plan a course sequence if the goal is to incorporate a semester of study abroad into the EnvE curriculum. It is not the only way to include a semester abroad while meeting the major requirements, but it is a plan that may work for many students. Students should use this as a starting point for planning, discuss options with their advisors, and make use of other advising resources to devise an individual plan.

It includes some assumptions:

- The student accepts no advanced placement credit (other variations may be possible depending on AP credit, summer classes, and other interests).
- The student is going abroad for one semester.
- **Those interested in a year abroad should consider the Cornell-Cantabria program.**
